Aquarion Wins Top DEP Award for the Second Year in a Row

Water system serving Hingham, Hull and North Cohasset is among the top water systems in the state

HINGHAM, MA. – For the second year in a row, Aquarion Water Company has received an award “For Outstanding Performance and Achievement” from the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) for its water system serving Hingham, Hull, and North Cohasset.

At the Public Water System Awards Day Ceremony, held on May 5th in Gloucester, the Aquarion system serving Hingham, Hull and North Cohasset was one of 41 public water supply systems in the state to receive an award.

For over two decades, MassDEP has given these awards to acknowledge the many dedicated water professionals whose accomplishments in delivering consistent and safe potable water to residents are worthy of special recognition. All of the state’s 1,735 public water systems were eligible for this award, but only a select few were chosen by MassDEP for this honor.

During the ceremony, Aquarion Vice President of Operations John Walsh was presented with a citation signed by Governor Charles Baker that stated: “On behalf of the citizens of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, I am pleased to confer upon you this Governor’s Citation in recognition of your dedicated service to maintaining a safe, abundant supply of clean water and in your commitment to protecting this valuable natural resource.”

Walsh said Aquarion is dedicated to providing high quality water and great service. Walsh added that “It’s nice to see the hard work of our employees recognized with this award”.
